

FOOD RESOURCE CENTER



(men and women) of high-yielding disease-resistant varieties of cassava, dwaf palms, peanut, cow pea and vegetable seeds help rural and urban families grow their own food. Marketing and sales training help them achieve dreams of better housing, education for their children and transport of produce to markets. Farmer groups work collectively in community fields and rotate collectively amoung the family plots of their members to profit from decreased labor burden on the families and discount prices for seeds, materials and transport of their produce to market.

Caleb and Alair Mitchell joined the New Hope Uganda Ministries in 2008. New Hope was founded on the belief that God's design for family was intended for all children to experience, even the thousands of orphaned children in Uganda. Today, New Hope Uganda brings the theology of the Fatherhood of God and God's design for family to hundreds of orphaned, fatherless, and abandoned children.





In 2002, when many non-profits were banned or labeled suspect in restricted access countries. Al began helping western believers establish genuine businesses as a means of sharing the gospel. In 2006, Al and his teammates at Global Disciples began providing business training and seed funds to indigenous church-planters. The team authored an asset-based business training that, as of 2012, has helped over 1,000 indigenous church-planters launch businesses. These businesses give them an accepted identity and role in the community that enables them to

> bring the good news of Jesus while providing for their families.



Guatemala Village of Hope VILLAGE OF

Village of Hope-Guatemala is a ministry of Lifesong for Orphans in partnership with Project Hopeful.

Village of Hope (VOH) cares for special needs orphans + HIV/AIDS children in San Lucas, Guatemala, while teaching them about the love of Jesus Christ, The vision for Village of Hope was born out of the knowledge that God has a heart for the "least of these." Scripture reveals a God who is passionate about the sick, the widow, the orphan, the alien, and the poor. Our purpose is to provide family, faith, and a future through holistic orphan care to special needs orphans, primarily focusing on those living with HIV/AIDS. We avoid an institutional atmosphere by providing a family style setting. Our hope is to create a family unit as God intended: to provide life-long support and to teach children Christian life values.
